OKANA

Set on the banks of the Oklahoma River, OKANA Resort and Indoor Waterpark will open Feb. 21. The \$400 million project funded in large part by the Chickasaw Nation features an 11-story hotel, 4.5-acre outdoor lagoon, dozens of restaurants and bars and an indoor waterpark. The resort estimated the getaway will add about 800 direct and indirect jobs once it begins operating.
